ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Leaving Certificate or Quality and Qualifications Ireland (QQI) Level 4. Mature candidates are welcome. Candidates must have a background in computer aided design and/or will have worked in the precast concrete industry for some time. Applicants must be under the supervision of an experienced Autocad Technician.

COURSE FEES:

Core course content costs are covered by Cavan Monaghan Education & Training Board as it is an identified regional skills development initiative. The "Concrete Ticket" course is provided at a cost of €150 per candidate.
